Elit Foal Auction Live

Before the Auction

The foals are presented with videos and photos on swbauction.swb.org and on the SWB social media channels. They will also be available for viewing online in the SWB information booth and in the auction catalog available at SWB Equestrian Weeks.

The foals are nominated for this event by the SWB selection committee; Johan Ifverson, Rick Jespers and Boudewijn Schepers as particularly promising young prospects for the future as elite sport horses.

The foals will go through a vet check two times before the auction. The first vet check is done no earlier than two weeks before the foals/horses are published on the site swbauction.swb.org and the result will be published on the foal's/horse auction page. The foals/horses will also go through a vet check in the morning of the auction. The veterinary certificates will be posted on the individual stalls in the stabling area.

Please observe that there may be findings noted on the health certificate. SWB and Agria Djurförsäkring (Agria Animal Insurance) recommend that interested parties be sure to view the certificates before the auction.

Auction stabling area

The foals with their dams will be stabled in a designated stabling area at Flyinge and available to view on the day of the Auction between **2.00-3.00 pm** and **5.30-6.30 pm**. Feel free to contact the seller, should you wish to view the foal or horse outside its stall. Owner contact info will be posted on each stall respectively. Interested parties may also contact Johan Ifverson, Rick Jespers or Boudewijn Schepers should they wish for more information on the foals.

Pre-auction viewing

The foals and horses will be available for viewing in the outdoor riding arena "Kastanjegården" at 1 pm on the day of the auction. The pre-viewing will be broadcast live via swbauction.swb.org and **ClipMyHorse.TV**.

During the Auction

The foals will be shown in motion. The bidding begins. The bidding will take place both on site in the auction arena and online via ClipMyHorse.

The Auctioneer will determine when the bidding has reached its high point and when the hammer is to fall. If the bid is on site, the purchase contract shall shortly thereafter be signed by the person with the hammered winning bid. If the winning bid is placed online the contract is signed and valid as soon as the bid is placed.

Bidding on site

Registration to bid is not required to bid on a foal on site.

Phone bids

Bidding online

Should you not be able to attend in person, the opportunity to bid online is an option. If you are interested in bidding online, you need to register and log in to the auction site; swbauction.swb.org

SWB needs to accept you as a bidder before you can place a bid. This is the only site from where you can place a bid.

Insurance in partnership with Agria Animal Insurance

Every foal is insured through Agria Animal Insurance. Coverage is from the time of the hammer until December 31, 2025. The foal is insured in Agria Limited Life to 100% of the purchase price, including commission and VAT (maximum 300 000 SEK). It is also insured in Horse Extra Veterinary Care up to a maximum of 80 000 SEK.

Complete insurance information can be found on swbauction.swb.org. The Buyer will receive a special offer to further extend the insurance while at the auction.

Streaming online

The pre-viewing of the foals, and the auction itself, is broadcast live via swbauction.swb.org without delays.

The pre-viewing and the auction are also streamed online via ClipMyHorse.TV. These viewings may have a delay of up to 20 seconds.

Final purchase price

+ Hammer price + VAT 25% (if appropriate)

+ Buyer's premium 9% of hammer price + 25% VAT including insurance cover with Agria

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
